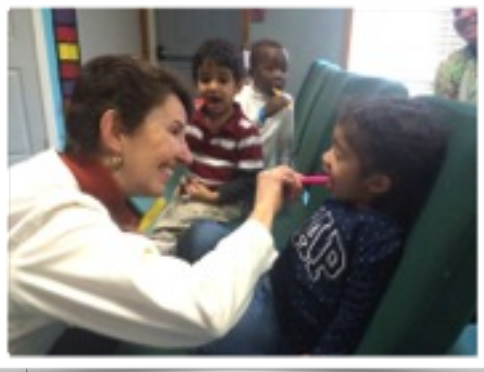

Standardized Testing

During the week of April 6-10, Kindergarten through 12th Grade will be participating in Standardized Testing. Here's how BCA students can prepare for each day of this week:

1. Each student should come to school with **three sharpened # 2 pencils**. No mechanical pencils, please.
2. **Grades 6 - 12** should bring a **simple calculator (4-function only)** for the Math portion of their test.
3. It is very important that your child(ren) **get plenty of sleep** each night and **eat a nutritious breakfast** each morning. Also, please send a few **extra-healthy snacks and drinks** in to be eaten during the breaks between tests. Please send in a water bottle as well.

Please do not schedule your child for any appointments during testing times, and make every effort to have your child at school on time. **Arrival times** remain the same for all students; **departure times** remain the same for all students. Testing will only take part of the day. During non-testing times, there will be **regular classes**. Make sure that your child is prepared for all classes (during non-testing time), including Physical Education.



Spiritual Emphasis Week

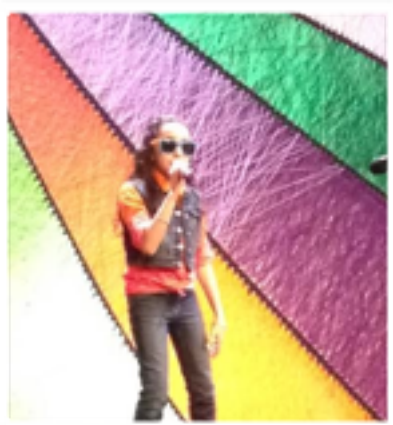
BCA held its annual Spiritual Emphasis Week March 23-27. Our theme this year was “Surrender” and the main verse for the week was Matthew 16:24-25:
